Importance of 24 June Elections in Turkey: Changes and New Regulations

On June 24, General Elections of the Parliament and the President Elections will be held. StratejiCo. explains the major changes that will be taking place for the first time.



The number of deputies in the parliament will rise from **550** to **600**.



For the first time, the presidential and parliamentary elections will be held at the same time. Next elections will be held in **5** years.



In the **new presidential system**, there will be no prime minister and the elected president may assign his/her vice-presidents without the necessity of being the members of the parliament.



Political parties will be able to form an **electoral alliance**.



The cabinet of ministers will be picked by the president and will not need the **vote of confidence** from the parliament.



The elected president **will not be discharged** from his/her political party.



The Grand National Assembly will be able to decide on the renewal of the elections with a majority of **3 out of 5 all members**. The president can also call for the renewal of the presidential and parliamentary elections.



Nominees of political parties and independent candidates who get more than **100 thousand signatures** can run in the presidential elections.
